ABOUT US & FEES

TVMS is managed by Stockton Borough Council.

TVMS is one of the UK's Biggest music services, covering the boroughs of Hartlepool, Redcar & Cleveland, Middlesbrough and Stockton on Tees. With a team of vastly experienced and professional tutors, TVMS takes the young people of the area from their very first steps into music at the foundation stage, through primary, secondary, sixth form and beyond.

Our tuition costs are currently £18.59 per month (instalments paid September to July) for the first year of tuition. This includes membership of our bands, orchestras and choirs, once your child has reached a suitable level of playing.

- ◆ Instrument hire is currently **£9.90 per month** regardless of which instrument you hire.
- ◆ If our teacher has recommended individual tuition this is currently **£39.05 per month** (20 minutes) or **£47.96 per month** (30 minutes) subject to availability. Paired tuition may be available at **£35.75 per month** subject to availability.
- ◆ If you are entitled to certain income based benefits your child/children receive a **50% discount** on fees
- ◆ If you have more than one child learning through TVMS there is a **25% sibling discount**. This discount also applies to those learning a **second instrument**.
- ◆ All pupils **MUST** be registered with TVMS before lessons can begin.
